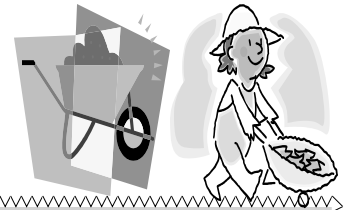




LANDSCAPE DESIGN

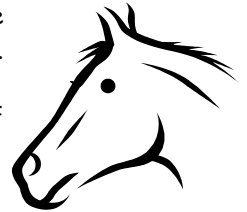
HORSEBACK RIDING
