Cumming Recreation & Parks Department Suspension Extended to April 12th

CUMMING, Ga. – Due to continued concerns over the novel coronavirus (Covid-19) outbreak, the Cumming Recreation & Parks Department has extended the suspension of all programs and activities through Sunday, April 12, at which time a re-evaluation of the safety concerns will be made. The Recreation Department will announce updated plans sometime during the week of April 5-11.

Programs and activities will resume from the point in their schedules that they were interrupted after the City of Cumming has deemed it safe to return.

Registration for future sessions of the Recreation Department's Gymnastics, Dance, Drama, and Art programs and classes will be postponed until a resolution of the current situation is reached. FitPasses will be frozen at their current status and will be reinstated with the resumption of programs.

In addition, all facility rentals during the suspension of the Recreation Department will be cancelled and no new facility rentals will be accepted requesting dates earlier than May 18, 2020. Facility rentals already booked for the foreseeable future are urged to consider alternative dates outside the window of program suspensions.
