Cumming City Center Buy-A-Brick Program Deadline Extended Through December

CUMMING, Ga. – City of Cumming officials have extended the deadline to purchase personalized, engraved bricks for placement at the Cumming City Center. The original purchase deadline of Nov. 22 has been extended through the end of December.

“We wanted to provide an extended timeline for the community to purchase bricks because we feel this is such a great opportunity to be a part of the City of Cumming’s history,” said Jennifer Archer, City Center Property Manager. “While we are selling a limited number of bricks, there are still plenty available and we want to make sure that every person or organization who wants a brick has an opportunity to purchase one.”

Looking for the perfect holiday gift? Why not order a brick for your family, friends, co-workers, or anyone else for whom you need to purchase a gift? Certificates of purchase can be obtained at no additional cost. To obtain an certificate after your brick(s) has been purchased, simply email Jennifer Archer at jarcher@cityofcumming.net and request a certificate, which will be provided electronically.

“The certificates themselves are very nice and are even suitable for printing and framing,” Archer said. “The City is providing these at no additional cost beyond the brick purchase cost, so we hope the community will really get behind the idea of purchasing City Center bricks as Christmas gifts.”

Each standard 4-inch by 8-inch brick can be purchased for \$50, and personalization includes up to three lines of text with each line allowing for up to 18 characters (characters include all letters, numbers, punctuation marks and spaces). The City reserves the right to review and edit all text for appropriateness without notice to the purchaser.

The Buy-A-Brick Program is a great opportunity for families, businesses, civic organizations, churches, schools and any other group to become part of the Cumming City Center’s legacy for generations to come. The Cumming City Center is slated to open in fall of 2021 with a wide variety of retail, restaurant, entertainment, and park amenities. Situated on 75 acres between Canton Hwy. (Hwy. 20 West) and Sawnee Drive, behind Forsyth Central High, the Cumming City Center will offer a “main-street Americana” feel with an amphitheater, mini golf course, large and small park spaces, a walking and biking trail and boardwalk system that will eventually connect to the Big Creek Greenway, water features, new Cumming Police and Municipal Court facility, and approximately 117,000 square feet of retail space.
