

## Addendum #2

1. Will the project deadline for proposal submissions be extended? **Yes, January 19, 2022.**
2. Will a Landscaping allowance/budget be provided? **No.**
3. Will the City acquire additional easements on SR 306 if required? **Yes.**
4. Will the City bear the cost of any environmental permitting/mitigation credits? **Yes.**
5. Have any GDOT traffic studies been performed for the intersection at SR306 and the new road to include sight and distance and signalization? **No.**
6. Do we have a sight plan of the City Center that shows how and where the connection will be to the new road? **Yes, see exhibit 1. This should include grading, draining and utility plan sheets.**
7. Has any geo-tech work been performed on the property that will be affected by the new road? **No.**
8. Has any sub-surface work on the property been completed? **No.**
9. What types of plans will be required to be approved for the project? For the sake of submitting a proposal, a conceptual plan is sufficient. Eventually, the awarded contractor will need to supply the following for approval:
  1. **Erosion, Sedimentation and Pollution Control plans for Land Disturbance.**
  2. **Roadway plans, including typical cross sections.**
  3. **Utility Coordination plans (The contractor will be responsible for all utility coordination).**
  4. **Plans and permitting for GDOT for encroachments on the SR306 entrance. A signal warrants analysis will need to be completed.**
  5. **Plans and permitting with the GA EPD and/or US Army Corps of Engineers for any encroachments on US waters and/or the buffers of state waters.**
  6. **Plans for the encroachment in the GDOT state right of way.**
