The 2021 Cumming Christmas Parade is scheduled to begin at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, December 4, 2021 . The parade will be held rain or shine. All parade participants must gather at the FORSYTH CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL parking lot no later than 4:00 p.m.			
You may drop off participants at the entrance to the line-up area NO CARS ARE ALLOWED in the LINE-UP AREA OTHER THAN THOSE PARTICIPATING IN THE PARADE; ANY OTHERS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE! We will have many moving vehicles in the parade, and extras only prohibit an efficient line-up. Parade workers will be on site to give you instructions.			
The Cumming Christmas Parade will be held during evening hours and will be a "lighted" parade, meaning floats and other entries should incorporate Christmas lights into their entries if at all possible. Please note, that all entrants are responsible for providing their own lights and any means of illumination necessary, as well as all other decorations for entries. Representatives of City of Cumming, event sponsors, event workers and volunteers will NOT provide or be responsible for any decorative or illumination items. Also, please do not include anyone dressed as a traditional Santa Claus (red & white suit, white beard, white hair, etc.) as a part of any entry as the City will have an official Santa in the parade and others create confusion for children. Non-traditional Santa's (examples: Blue or green "Santa suit"; female in "Santa suit" with no beard; children or animals in "Santa suit" or hat, etc.) are permitted.			
All entrants must sign this release form and return it to Crystal Ledford (Cumming City Hall, 100 Main Street, Cumming, GA 30040 <i>OR</i> cledford@cityofcumming.net) by 5 p.m. Monday, November 29, 2021 in order to participant in the parade. No entries will be accepted after 5 p.m. on Monday, November 30, 2020.

Parade Contest Information

A committee of private citizens, selected in advance by parade organizers, will judge all parade entries on the day of the parade. **One award per each of the following categories** will be presented. Certificates will be presented to the winners.

After you have completed and returned your Parade Registration Form, you will be provided an **Entry Number**. **This Entry Number MUST BE VISIBLY DISPLAYED** as follows:

- 1. The number must be plainly written in **BLACK marker or ink on a PLAIN, WHITE card stock** or **poster board**, measuring **at least 8.5 in. x 11 in. and not larger than 22 in. x 28 in**.
- 2. Please provide **two copies of your entry number** and place **one on each side of your entry** in areas that will be easily visible to the judges. (NOTE: Walking groups need only carry one copy of their entry number at the beginning of their group.)
- 3. Number must be displayed on your entry throughout the entire lineup time period prior to the parade start, and throughout the parade.
- 4. If number is not placed appropriately on the vehicle or if number becomes detached at any point, your entry may not be judged.
- 5. Please note: Your entry number is NOT an assignment in the parade lineup. With a few specific exceptions (emergency services vehicles, City of Cumming float, and high school bands, etc.), the parade lineup will be determined on a "first come, first serve" basis on the day of the parade as space within the lineup area allows, and as determined by parade workers and volunteers. The entry numbers will be used ONLY by the Parade Contest judges to help them determine one winner in each contest category and for no other purpose.
- 6. A certificate will be presented to the winner of each category. Certificates can be picked up from Crystal Ledford at Cumming City Hall (Third Floor) anytime between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday-Friday during the two-week period after the parade. Any certificates not claimed by 5 p.m. on Friday, Dec. 17, 2021, will be disposed of.
